GENEVA LAKE MUSKIES – FALL ANGLING TECHNIQUES

Guide Ide Fishing Service offers guided fishing trips in Southeast Wisconsin for Bass, Walleye, Pike, Muskie and Crappie! Doug fishes many of the area lakes: Geneva, Delavan, Beulah, Eagle Springs, and Pewaukee among others! His motto is "The best time to go fishing is whenever YOU can!" Southeast Wisconsin lakes are famous for Bass, and Captain Doug Ide is so accomplished that he has earned 100% sponsorship for his Guide Service. What does that mean for you? That YOU get to fish on a brand-new boat and use brand new equipment! The sponsors provide Captain Doug with new gear every Spring, and he keeps the gear in pristine condition until next year's new equipment arrives.
