Sam Veith – Fishing For Good Foundation

Early Season Strategies – Geneva & Delavan Lakes

Sam Veith is the current owner/operator of Fun Fishin' Guide Service (funfishin.org) on Geneva and Delavan Lakes. He moved to Wisconsin a few years ago to fish more and started part-time guiding in 2020. Sam's fishing education and experience also includes the Spence Petros Fishing School in 2008; being a First Mate aboard the Erie Drifter Sportfishing charter boat on Lake Erie for two seasons; and multiple guided trips with John Trossen, William "Billy" Heim and Steve Everetts on Geneva and Delavan.

Veith founded the Fishing for Good, Inc. a 501(c)(3) charity in January 2021. Fishing For Good's mission is simply to give back through fishing and find ways to use the sport to help others. Sam's effort is all about giving back to Veterans and promoting fishing as a therapeutic activity to combat PTSD & mental illness. Many businesses and individuals funded guide trips for many veterans last year. Sam started by having companies sponsor fishing trips for active-duty military, veterans and first responders. All trips are run with licensed professional fishing guides to ensure all participants are having a fun unique experience. Fishing For Good has expanded to five local guides who provide charitable trips on Geneva and Delavan. The plan is to expand to Lake Michigan and other bodies of water for the 2022 season and beyond.

Sam's presentation will cover various seasonal patterns for Geneva and Delavan game and pan fish. The presentation will include one of his favorite summer techniques which is drop shooting plastic worms for bass. Veith has also discovered and fine-tuned a HOT pattern on Geneva, the fall & winter trolling bite for walleyes – both numbers of fish and trophies.
