LIVE-BAIT RIGGING FOR GENEVA SMALLMOUTH

Bob Clark is the current President and Secretary of the club; he also was the 2019 Club Champion, two times Club Lakes Champion, and with Jim Bloede won the initial Back Yard Battle tournament. He does most of his local fishing on Geneva and would like to share his knowledge of the live-bait bite for Geneva's smallmouth bass.

Clark will be sharing how he and his boat mates catch small yellow perch to use for bait and then uses his electronics and trolling motor to find and catch smallmouth bass as well as other game fish. Using perch for smallmouth has been a known technique for many years but has been changing from a later season bite to a post-pawn through the open-water season bite. He will also share some other not so well-known live bait tactics.

While this is a widely used technique on Geneva, it is rare to see publicly seminar on the subject and Bob will share some unique perspective on the process of finding bait and using other tools to achieve success.
