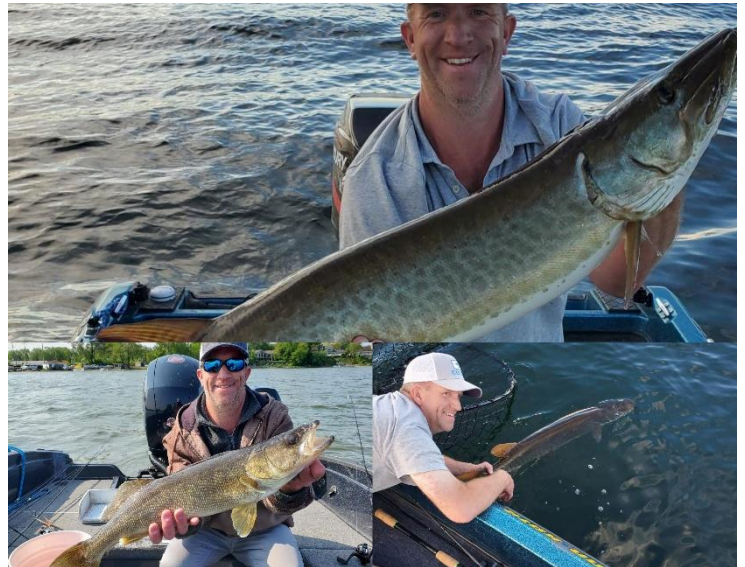

All guide trips include fishing out of a fully rigged Recon walleye boat with Mercury outboard and kicker, Minn Kota trolling motor and Humminbird electronics. Musky Fishing Outings will consist of catch and release fishing only. Providing clients with an educational day on the water. There are many reports of 50 inch and longer now residing in Geneva.
